Sub: - Regarding cancellation of arbitrary transfer order issued on longest stay basis and considering of request transfer cases on completion of two years stay at working station.

Our association has requested to circle administration vide letter No. SNEA(I)/Rajasthan /Corr./2016-17/22 dated 24.03.2017 for considering request transfers of executives who has completed two years of stay at working station without transferring of executive on longest stay basis. Presently administration is having option to provide substitute in lieu of request transfer from the promotion list of JTOs.

Further on the banner of Joint Forum of BSNL Executives' Associations we have also requested vide JF/Raj/CGMT/15-16/04 dated 28-03-2017 and in personal meeting with you sir, we have requested that Corporate office issued a letter No. 250-7/2007/pers.III(part) on dated 7th March 2011 to all the heads of field units to instruct them that keeping present financial constrains in mind the financial implication should be NIL for transfer cases.

Six SSAs of Rajasthan Circle has been declared soft tenure station by corporate office to fill up the acute shortage in these stations up to bear minimum strength of executive to maintain BSNL services. Even though while considering inter circle request transfers by corporate office no any executive is being transferred from the soft tenure stations to maintain the status co of executive at these stations.

It is very surprising that overlooking the above communication and discussions with circle administration by our association and Joint Forum of BSNL Executives' Associations. Circle administration has issued the 51 transfer orders on longest stay basis vide STA/8-15/Ch-14/R-Trf/JTO/2017/11 dated 21.04.2017 including six of soft tenure stations which is contrary to BSNL executive transfer policy and corporate office letter dated 7th March 2011.

We have requested to consider the request transfers of executives those have completed two years of stay at their working station as per section A6(C) of BSNL executives' transfer policy. Circle administration has considered the request transfer of those executives who have completed four years of stay at working station.

So it is humbly requested that these arbitrary transfer orders issued on longest stay basis should be cancelled immediately and request transfers of executives those have completed two years at working station should be considered, so that harmony with association may not disturb.

I hope your good self will sympathetically considered our request and do needful to provide relief to executive so that they will work with full devotion and dedication to serve BSNL in better way.
