Sub.: Debarring on refusal for looking after arrangement on higher grade.

Circle office administration has making looking after arrangement in higher cadres as per guidelines received from corporate office, New Delhi. Due to personal problem some of the officers are unable to accept responsibility of higher post, in this case they have been barred for one year for considering them in next looking after arrangement in higher cadre.

In this regards there is no any guidelines issued from corporate office to debar them. In Rajasthan circle it is wrongly interpreted the guidelines issue with respect to refusal on regular promotion vide letter no. 400-204/2013-pers-I dtd.1.11.2013. In these guidelines the officer will be debarred for one year from the date of refusal by official, but in Rajasthan Circle, the officer is being debarred from the date of accepting of his refusal by competent authority, even for looking after arrangement also, contrary to corporate office guidelines for refusal on promotion by misinterpreting these guidelines at local level.

It is only a stop-gap-arrangement as per letter no. 412-13/2013-pers-I(II) dtd.22.03.13 issue by corporate office New Delhi. If these looking after arrangement is not a promotion then there should not be any debarring for consideration for next time to make looking after arrangement in higher cadre.

So it is requested that the officer should not be debarred on refusal for accepting high post on looking after arrangement. We hope that your good honor will look in to matter personally and provide relief to effected officers those are feeling humiliation while working under their junior officers.
