Sub: Acute Shortage of essential stores and grievances of members.

1. Acute shortage of essential store :-

Since last three months EPBT Telephone instruments are not available at Rajasthan Circle. Due to acute shortage of EPBT instruments NTC work is affecting badly, UG cable Joint closers of No2 and 3 are also running short since long. So maintenance work is also badly affecting. An essential meter i.e. power meters for maintenance and installation work of transmission network are also running short since long. Drop wire is also running short since last one year so due to shortage of these essential stores development and maintenance work of telephone network is adversely affecting it is requested that these essential stores for development and maintenance work should be arranged immediately by diversion from other circle or by procurement through open market or telecom factory so that outdoor network may not suffer any more.

2. Abnormal delay in time bound up gradation cases:

Time bound upgradation case has to be submitted six months advance to due date for conducting DPCs at circle level twice in a year, but it has been observed that most of the SSAs are not serious in reviewing these cases and not forwarding the cases even after passing of due dates before one year or more. Due to this abnormal delay in submission of cases to circle office time bound up gradation cases of executives are getting badly delayed. Not a single SSA head has submitted certificates to circle office in this regards that no any case is overdue or pending at SSA level. So it is requested that all SSA heads should be strongly warned to submit the time bound up gradation cases in six months advance to due date twice a year and also fix responsibility of erring officer for delay submission of cases.

3. Improper implementation of BA concept in Rajasthan circle:

Business area concept has been implemented in the month of Nov 2016 in Rajasthan circle. BA concept is planned to improve the system efficiency by merging of some streams of functioning with big SSA and sparing the staff for deployment in field to improve the quality of service of telecom network. The staff sparing by merging of HR and planning of small SSAs has not been properly deployed in field work and at the same time at parent SSAs in HR and planning section no adequate staff has been posted to copup the extra work diverted from small SSAs. Due to this mismatching of work force the working efficiency of the SSAs has been deteriorated instead of improving. The merging SSAs are also facing hardship of funds due to lack of work flow

planning at parent SSAs. So it is requested that proper deployment of staff and work flow plan has to be ensured to get the proper mileage of this BA concept in Rajasthan circle.

4. Request transfer cases of JTOs:

50 JTO trainees were posted for 4 weeks field training vide STA/11-68/Deptt. JTO/ Ch-7/2016/61 dated 23-12-2016 w.e.f. 26-12-2016 and thereafter posted as JTO. While posting of these trainees for field training request of four JTOs have been considered by circle administration on pick and choose basis without any justified ground. Association strongly protested this move of circle administration to CGMT Rajasthan. Then CGMT assured for not to consider any advance requested transfer in this field training order. Even after commitment of CGMT Rajasthan four JTOs have been transferred in back date from soft tenure stations leaving others and got relieved by creating pressure on SSA head. This type of decisiveness with association is highly objectionable and not acceptable at all. We have demanded that if circle administration wants to oblige these four JTOs by releasing advance work order than all the request transfer orders should be released in advance with remarks that officer should be relieved on completion of stipulated time period.

5. Retention of Mrs. Chetanya Sharma at Jaipur till 31st March 2018:

Mrs. Chetanya Sharma was transferred from Jaipur TD to Ajmer TD vide letter No. STA/8-15/2h-9/JTO/R-TFR/2012-103 dtd.11.05.2012. She met an accident on 12 Nov.2012 due to falling from ladder and got fractured in L1 disc collapse. She remains in bed for six months. Her orders kept held in abeyance vide STA/8-15/Ch8/JTO-R-TFR/2014-185 dtd.30.01.2013, STA/8-15/Ch9/JTO/2012/59 dtd.08.07.2013, STA/8-15/Ch-9/JTO/R-Tfr/2012/83 dtd.29.11.2013, STA/8-15/Ch-9/JTO/R-Tfr/2012/86 dtd.03.01.2014 and STA/8-15/Ch.11/JTO/R-Tfr/2014/47 dtd.03.07.2014 dtd.30.09.2014 up to 30.09.2014. She has been relieved vide ST-2/12/JTO/Trf & postg/KW/15-16/195 dtd.06.04.2016 from PGMTD, Jaipur for Ajmer TD and retained at Jaipur vide STA/8-15/JTO/R-Tfr/2012/105 dated 09/08/2016 till 31/12/2016. Her recent X-Ray Lumbo sacral spine AP /LAT view report is attached with this letter. The report shows wedging of elapse of L1 vertebra and reduces joint space between L5-S1 vertebrae. Doctor advised for avoiding sternness activities like driving of vehicle, using stairs, continuous sitting, travelling etc. otherwise she can meet to paralysis. In this situation she alone cannot service out of Jaipur. So it is requested that her transfer order may please be retained till 31st March 2018 on humanitarian ground. After this period she will seek voluntary retirement from service due to her poor health.

6. Request transfer case of Mr. N L Meena TDM Jaisalmer:

Mr. N L Meena has served as SDE at Banswara hard tenure station since 2000 to 2003 for three years. He has also served as AGM at corporate office New Delhi since 24/12/2012 to 30/11/2015. On returning from corporate office New Delhi he has been posted at Jaisalmer vide STA/8-11/TD/ch-LIX/2015-16/31 dtd 21/07/2015. Mr. Meena Has been relieved from corporate office on 30/11/2015 and joined on 02/12/2015 at Jaisalmer. On promotion as DGM in the month of March 2016 he has been posted as TDM at Jaisalmer and joined as TDM on 04/05/2016. His father is running in the age of 86 years and suffering from oldage ailments. Looking at his service at hard tenure for three years and out of Rajasthan for three years and more than one year at

Jaisalmer and his family circumstances his own cost request for posting him at Alwar should be considered as an earliest.

7. Request transfer case of Mr. Sita Ram Saini TDM Barmer:

Mr. S R Saini had served at corporate office New Delhi as AGM w.e.f. 08/09/2011 to 25/10/2014 for more than three years. He has been transferred from corporate office to Rajasthan circle on his own cost and posted at Jhunjhunu SSA. On his promotion as DGM he has been posted as TDM Barmer. He has joined at Barmer on 30/04/2016. Mr Saini is going to retire on Superannuation on 28th Feb 2018 just after 11 months. Mr. Saini is also suffering from various diseases i.e. Hernia, Prostate, Liver disorder etc. Looking at to his personal problems and poor health his own cost request for transfer to Jhunjhunu or Jaipur should be considered.

8. Request transfer case of Mr. Sanjeev Kumar Chouhan from Rajasthan circle to UP (East) circle:

Mr. Sanjeev Kumar Chouhan JTO Jaisalmer has been working at Jaisalmer soft tenure station since 12/01/2004 continuously. Mr. Chouhan has been promoted as JTO from TTA cadre and posted as JTO on 31/03/2014. Before this date he had worked as TTA at same station. His wife Mrs. Anjali Chouhan has been appointed as Govt. teacher at Sitapur under Khairabad UP (East) circle on 08/01/2016. Mr. Chouhan is having two children of age three years and 10 years. Those are living with his wife at Sitapur. Mr. Chouhan has applied for transfer to UP (East) circle under rule-8. He is going to complete three years regular service on 31/03/2017. So it is requested that by relaxing the time period of five years of continuous service in the present cadre for eligibility condition for transfer under rule-8, his case has to be forwarded on humanitarian ground.

I hope your honour will personally look in to these issues and settle them earliest to provide the relief to our members.
